

DEFINITIONS OF YOUTH DISCIPLINARY DISCHARGES

Youth may be asked to leave the Shelter for any of the following reasons. This list is not all-inclusive and may be modified without notice.

Arson: Youth threatens to or sets fire, which presents imminent danger to life and/or property.

AWOL/Walkout: Youth who leave during the night will not be allowed to return that same night.

Bullying: See Harassment and Threatening.

Breaking Special Agreement: Resident violates special agreements with FYA staff.

Drug Paraphernalia, Possession: Resident is found in possession of drug paraphernalia at shelter.

Drugs or Alcohol, Possession: Youth is displaying to others they have drugs or alcohol.

Drugs or Alcohol, Sale or Distribution: Youth sells or distributes illegal drugs/alcohol after point of check-in, in shelter.

Fighting/Physical Abuse of Resident: Youth engages in fight with other residents or physically assaults residents, on the premises.

Gangs: Recruiting or engaging in gang-related activity on the shelter premises.

Harassment (Threatening): Youth displays behavior either verbal or physical to degree that other youth or staff do not feel safe at shelter.

Intentional Destruction of Property: Resident intentionally destroys property of other residents, staff, or of the facility.

Late: Resident returns to shelter after exiting, within the same night.

Loitering: Resident loiters in areas designated as inappropriate for residents.

Other Serious Action: Youth engages in serious inappropriate actions, as determined by staff.

Physical Abuse of Staff: Youth physically assaults staff inside or outside of shelter.

Prostitution: No one shall engage in prostitution while *at* the shelter.

Refusal to Allow Contraband Search: Guest refuses to allow staff to search for weapons, drugs, alcohol, paraphernalia when requested. *Youth will only be searched if (ask FPD)

Resident Over Age: Youth has attained their 21st birthday. Will be referred to FRM.

Stealing: Youth participates in theft of property in shelter.

Verbal Abuse: Youth engages in on-going, threatening, assaultive, or slanderous verbal behavior directed toward staff or other youth.

Weapons, Possession or Use: Youth uses weapon during stay or is discovered to be in possession of weapon after Checkin.
