

TITLE: Counselor / Therapist, Licensed or eligible for licensing

PROGRAM: Clearwater Counseling

STATUS: Part time with potential for full time

SUMMARY: This position is primarily responsible for providing a range of clinically appropriate services to the general public. The agency will actively recruit clients for the counselor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Agrees with Article 3 of agency Bylaws, see website: fairbanksyouthadvocates.org.
- Masters Degree in Social Work, Psychology, or related discipline from an accredited educational institution.
- Experience working with disadvantaged youth and families in crisis, preferred.
- Ability to pass state, federal background checks.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide a variety of treatment services including individual, group, family, therapy.
2. Participate in liaison work with other agencies as required.
3. Participate as a member of an interdisciplinary treatment team.
4. Participate in regularly scheduled clinical supervision, as appropriate.
5. Maintain clinical records in accordance with insurance regulations & established policies and procedures.
6. Be available for rare but after-hours telephone contact for clients in crisis.
7. Work towards licensure or maintain current license with the State of Alaska.
8. Follow all state and federal laws regarding maintaining licensure including liability insurance.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES NECESSARY:

1. Ability to provide clinically sound treatment services based on client needs and treatment plans.
2. Demonstrates understanding of diagnostic evaluation methods, mental status exams, and use of the DSM-5.
3. Ability to respond to a range of clients' needs using differential diagnoses and treatment approaches.
4. Ability to provide appropriate crisis intervention services.
5. Ability to maintain clinical records in timely compliance with agency policies and procedures.
6. Ability to work collaboratively with other community agencies on behalf of clients and/or the agency.
7. Demonstrates understanding of sound ethical practice in conjunction with the established and defined ethics of one's training and discipline.
8. Ability to effectively organize time and responsibilities.

- Office space & billing services provided
- Counselors receives 50% of income generated.
- Supervision: Up to 50 hours of free supervision if candidate is working toward their LPC.
- Training: \$1200.00 be provided every 2 years for training
- Professional Liability Insurance: self paid
- Licensure: self paid
- \$1000 a month living expense stipend for one year depending on income.
