A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FROM THE DON AND LOIS YOICHEM NON-ENDOWED FUND, HELD BY THE ALASKA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING A FACILITIES MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, Fairbanks Youth Advocates (FYA), is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit corporation, established in the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, The mission of FYA is to shelter vulnerable youth in Fairbanks, Alaska, and

WHEREAS, In 2018, FYA established the Don and Lois Yochem Fund, a non-endowed fund held with the Alaska Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Don and Lois Yochem Fund is to enrich the lives of at-risk youth through programs that help them build a successful life; and

WHEREAS, The Yochem fund balance on June 30, 2022 was \$134,654.62; and

WHEREAS, The FYA board of directors wishes to prepare a facilities master plan, with the intent of future development at FYA's 10th avenue campus.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Fairbanks Youth Advocates Board of Directors authorizes Executive Director Brian Taylor to apply for a \$50,000 grant from the Don and Lois Yochem Fund for the purpose of preparing a comprehensive, facilities master plan for the 10th avenue campus.
